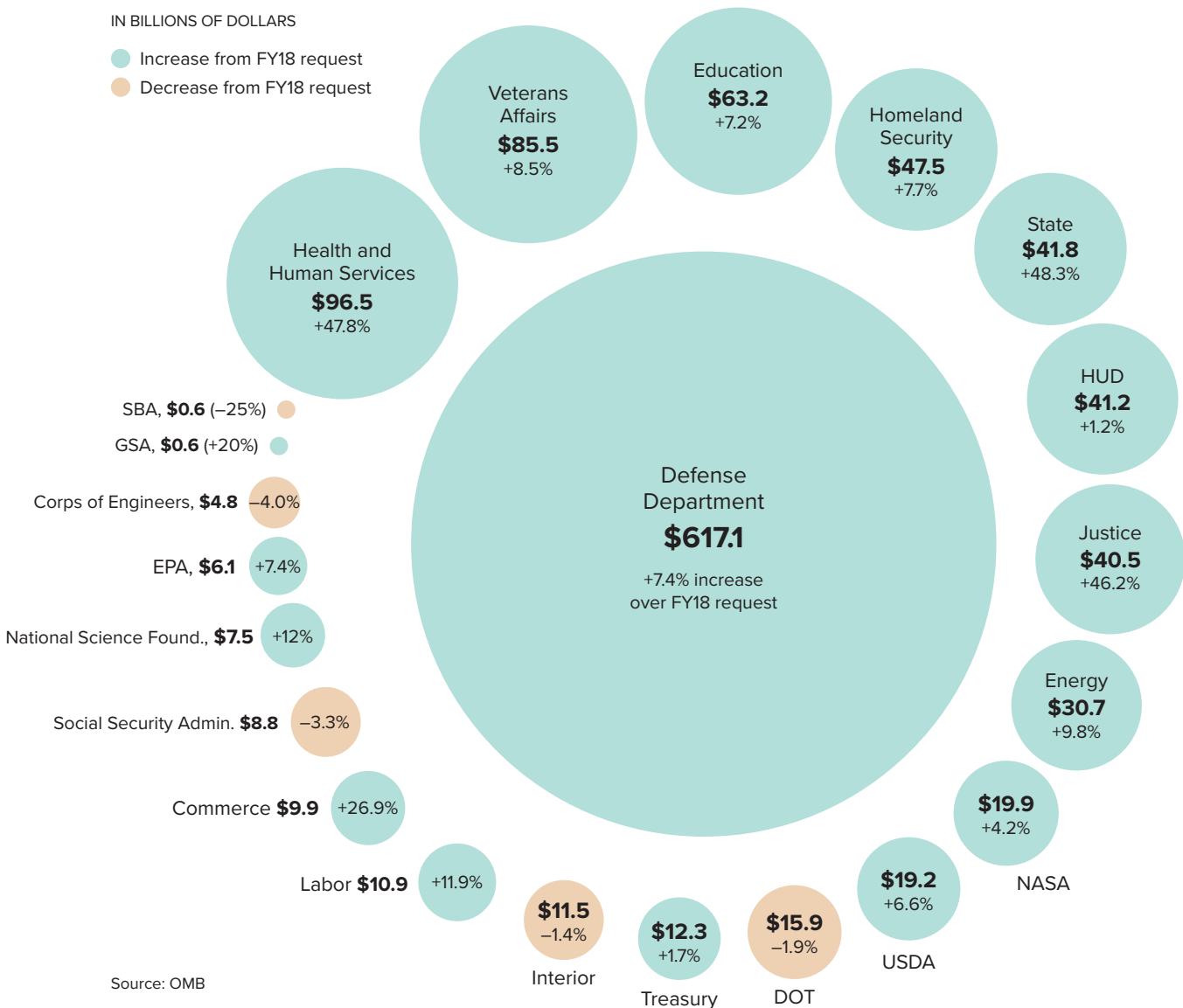
Trump's Budget Priorities, One Year Later

After proposing dramatic reductions in discretionary spending for most agency budgets in last year's fiscal 2018 budget request, President Donald Trump is suggesting a spending bump for agencies with the largest requested budgets, with an emphasis on the Defense, Veterans Affairs and Homeland Security departments, as well as HHS and Education. In response to Congress' recent agreement to raise budget caps in the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018, the administration is also proposing additional discretionary funding for several agencies above its initial proposal — including shifting over some line items from mandatory spending categories, as reflected in the budget request's addendum.
